David & Goliath Preschool (DGP)

1) DGP Bursary Scheme

As part of DGP's efforts to help the low-income households in the community, we are launching the DGP Bursary Scheme to provide school fee subsidies to qualifying students. Under this scheme, we will set aside 10% of DGP's student capacity for qualifying students. For a start, qualifying students will receive a bursary amount of up to 20% of net monthly school fees (after deducting all Government subsidies). In the longer term, we hope to offer greater financial support to students from low-income households.

To help fund this Bursary Scheme, we will be organising some fundraising initiatives (e.g. Open House) and would like to invite you to support us.

2) DGP Opening (Opening Ceremony & Open House)

Date: 27 Nov 2021 (Sat)

Venue: JCC

Objectives:

- a. **Announce/celebrate** our conversion into a Childcare
- b. Enhance our **visibility** by inviting prospective parents to our premises
- c. **Thank our stakeholders** who have helped us on this journey e.g. former teachers/staff/principals/MC members/volunteers
- d. **Donation drive** via the Open House (if this is permitted by authorities by then).
- e. **Goshen Initiative** – welcome the community into our church and ministries (e.g. Youth ministry, badminton, flower décor)

The original idea, conceived when the Covid numbers were still in the single digits, was to have an Open House on 27 Nov. In light of the current situation, the committee has decided to take a wait-and-see approach since we are about 4 months away. If the authorities permit us to organised a community event, we will ensure that the covid guidelines are followed. Alternatively, we may push back the Open House and only have a small-scale Opening Ceremony on 27 November. To supplement the Open House, we intend to carry out other low-key fundraising activities (e.g. T-shirt/cards/cookie sales to raise funds for our bursary).
