Notice to JCCians

We thank God for all JCCians who have been supporting each other and serving the Lord in this difficult season. Yes, we are called to look out for one another constantly and to spur each other to grow in the Lord.

After much consideration and deliberation on a few key factors, the JCC English Council and Pastoral team have decided to hold all Sunday services online from 27 Sept to 24 October 2021. During this period, all church activities are to be carried out via Zoom.

The reasons for this decision are:

- a) This is in line with the government's latest measures to help slow down the spread of Covid-19 in the community, especially for those above 60 years old and the children. We do our part as best as we can to follow the advisory from our government during this volatile time.
- b) Many of our brothers and sisters who are serving in the Sunday services are above 60 years old. In line with the latest government guidelines, we try not to get them to serve during this period. This means that the worship ministry team will need to look for younger members to replace them. This process takes time.

We never want to cancel Worship Services. If we cannot hold it onsite, we will continue to worship God online. In this period when Covid-19 has infected some of our brothers and sisters, it is out of love for God's family, in particular for our servers, that we take this step of moving our Services online.

We pray that even as we move into the online mode, all of us will continue to live out the life of discipleship daily. Let us be intentional to meet one-to-one and/or over Zoom to encourage each other. We can also continue to reach out to people who do not know Christ yet.

Let us pray for the worship team as they look for more members to serve in the onsite services. Pray also for the council as they make decisions for the Church.

Let us not waste this "difficult time". We ask the Lord for His grace to live impactful lives AND to build deeper intimacy with Him as we spend time in His Presence.

As the farmer waited patiently for the harvest, let us wait for Him to act through us in this endemic season.
