Many married couples had testified of the benefits they received as a result of these sessions with the Marriage Preparation Mentors.



KEY TOPICS


- What is the Christian perspective according to God's original design and why it matters?
- Who is responsible to teach our young about sexuality?
- How do we talk to a child/student about homosexuality and gender identity?

SYNOPSIS

Consciously or unconsciously, society expects parents and educators to have all the answers to life, including a hot trending issue like Sexuality.

Human Sexuality is a delicate topic. What is age-appropriate content? Who should be the one teaching our children about sexuality? Is UNESCO's *Comprehensive Sexuality Education* helpful at all?

Parents may find it awkward to talk about sexuality to their children. Teachers may find it a heavy responsibility, extra-curricular. It need not be that way. Help is available. And instead of zipping lips and letting social media shape the thinking of our children, we must draw from what God says about sexuality and point them in the way they should go. The parents' involvement is especially crucial because deep down, young people want their parents' guidance on sexuality matters.



David & Goliath Preschool ("DGP") Bursary

As part of DGP's community outreach efforts through the provision of childcare services, we have launched the DGP Bursary Scheme to enable children from low-income families to receive quality preschool education with DGP. For a start, qualifying children would enjoy up to 20% subsidy on their monthly net school fees.

Looking ahead into the future, it is our desire that DGP be able to offer greater financial assistance beyond the current subsidy cap of 20% to children from low-income families, especially to those below the 25th percentile of Singapore's population (i.e. less than \$3,000 gross monthly household income).

We appeal to JCC members to consider DGP as an outreach ministry of JCC and humbly seek your financial support through your tithes & offerings to finance this DGP Bursary Scheme. Please refer to the contribution details below.

Above all, we ask that you join us in prayer that through DGP the love of God may be shared with the children and their families, and many may come to receive salvation in Jesus Christ. Amen.

DGP Bursary Scheme

As part of DGP's efforts to help the low-income households in the community, we are launching the DGP Bursary Scheme to provide school fee subsidies to qualifying students. Under this scheme, we will set aside 10% of DGP's student capacity for qualifying students.

For a start, qualifying students will receive a bursary amount of up to 20% of net monthly school fees (after deducting all Government subsidies). In the longer term, we hope to offer greater financial support to students from low-income households.

To help fund this Bursary Scheme, we will be organising some fundraising initiatives and we would appreciate if you can support us.
