## 1. Dialogue - Promoting Restorative Initiatives to Address Sexual Harm in Campus

Participants from Singapore IHLs joined us for a session with Professor David Karp from the Center for Restorative Justice at the University of San Diego.

## 2. Empowerment Self Defense session

Instructors Lindsey and Lauren from Thrive Empowerment Center taught physical skills and provided a space to reflect on behaviours and thought processes as participants discussed about relationships, boundaries and consent.

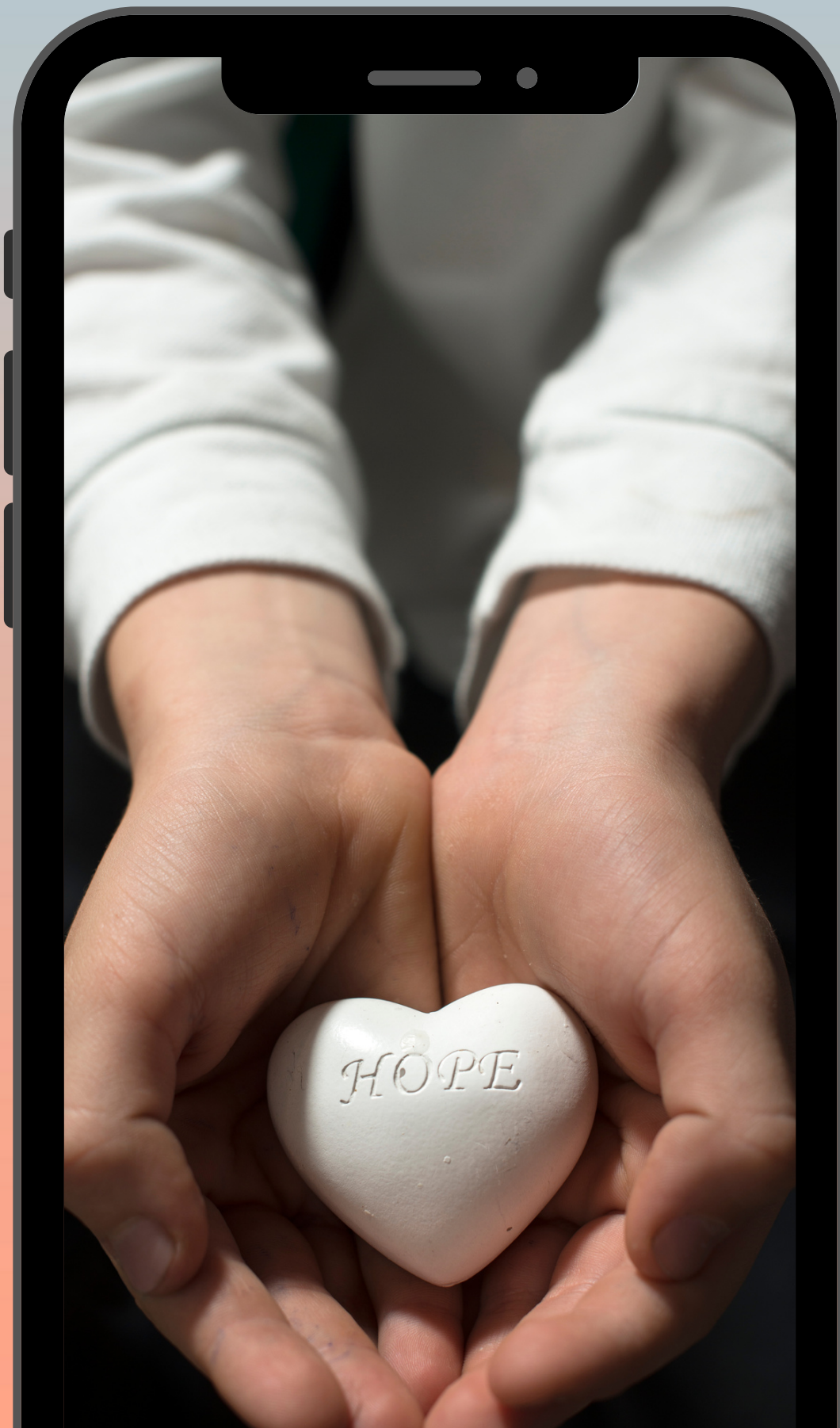

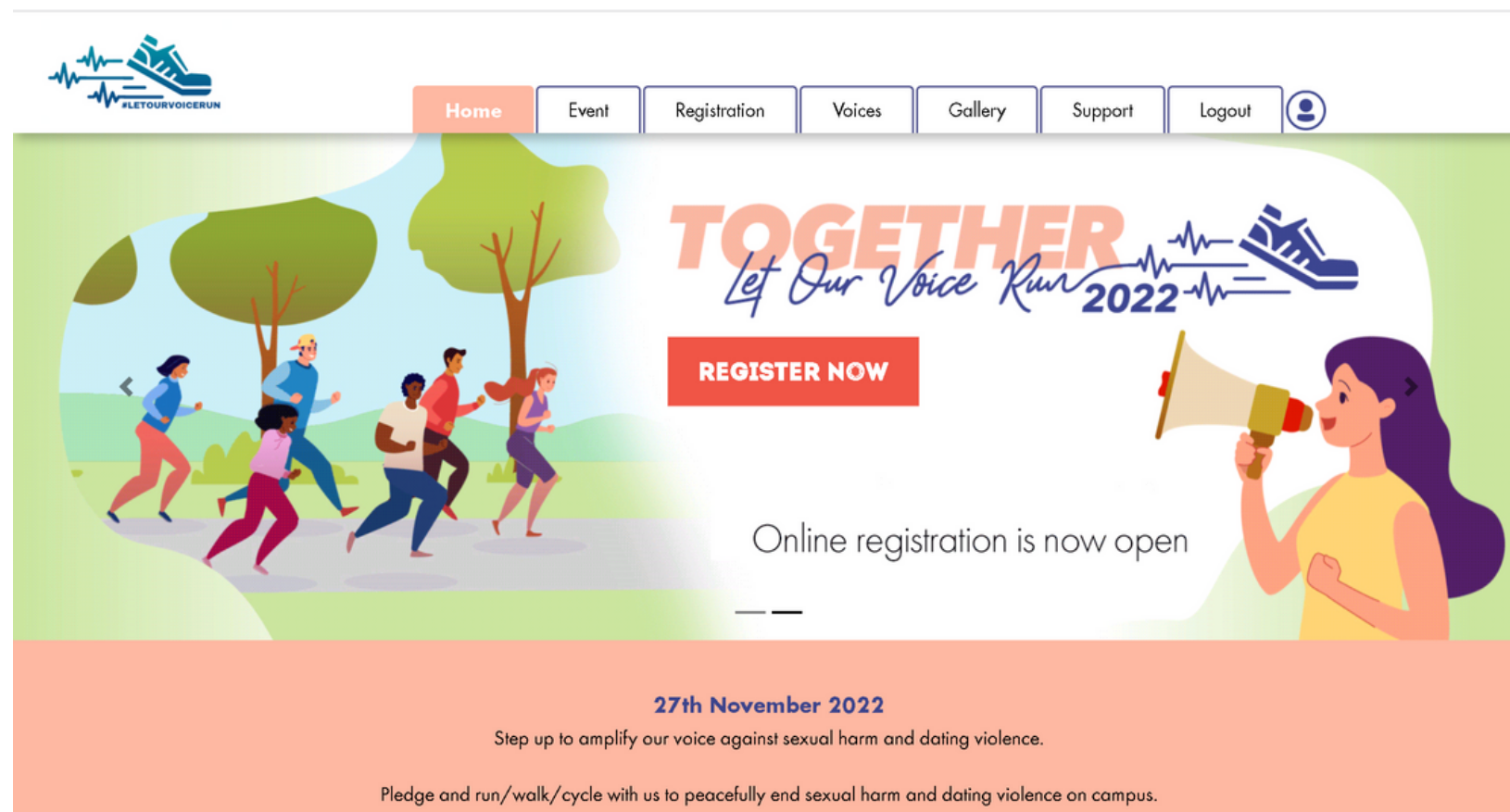

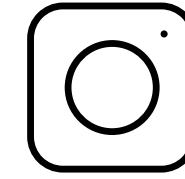
