
LOVR MISSION AND VISION

Support and bear witness to experiences of persons in IHLs who are involved in sexual harm and dating violence to promote healing. Engage students who want to address sexual harm and violence in IHLs to discover needs of peers experiencing violence and the change that needs to happen to create safe campus communities.




